

Dianella Caerulea

(Blue Flax Lilly)

This tidy Dianella spreads easily to fill gaps and out-compete nasty weeds. Quick to establish this is an excellent choice when you're looking for a clumping plant to provide texture in the garden quick smart!

Its long, green and strappy foliage looks great when mass planted, in rockeries, under-planting or along edges.

Delicate blue and yellow flowers appear in spring.

Will tolerate humidity, cold and is moderately drought tolerant.

Botanical name: Dianella caerulea

Common names: Blueberry lily, blue flax-lily

Height: 60-70 centimetres

Width: 60-70 centimetres

Ideal position

Can be planted in full sun or part shade.

Tolerates most soils however avoid very poor soils.

Caring tips

Keep the base of Dianella above the soil or mulch level.

Feed in spring with a slow release fertiliser in spring.

Trim older leaves as required and prune back to half the plant's size every three years to encourage healthy new growth.
